“Your child has Down Syndrome” are the dreaded words only another parent who has heard them can understand fully. Overwhelmed at first with confusion, shock, and fear, parents can feel very unprepared for the challenges that lie ahead. But every child is created in the image and likeness of God. And parents know more than anyone that their children with Down Syndrome imitate God’s love in an extraordinary way and bring a fullness to their families that they could not have imagined.

Still, the unknown road can be daunting, especially in a world that distorts authentic love. Our Office of Human Life, Family and Bioethics can help parents facing this diagnosis find resources, organizations and support networks that can help them greet their newborn child with enthusiasm, hope and the confidence of knowing they are not alone.
